

EXPANDED RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING

All Township Waste Haulers Now Have Single Stream Recycling

For Curbside Pickup Place All the Following in One or More Containers Marked as Recycling:

- **Newspapers/Magazines/Catalogs/Phone Books**
- **Paper Bags**
- **Paperback Books**
- **Junk Mail**
- **Office/Computer/Writing Paper** (place shredded paper in paper bag)
- **Milk and Juice Cartons (except Allied Waste)**
- **Glass Bottles & Jars** (clear, brown, or green glass containers)
- **Aluminum, Steel, Bi-metal and Tin Cans**
- **Aluminum Foil**
- **Pizza Boxes**
- **Plastic Bottles and Containers** (Stamped #1 thru #7)
- **Corrugated Cardboard** (must be flattened, no larger than approximately 2 ft by 2 ft)
- **Pressed Cardboard, such as cereal boxes, soda cases, paper egg cartons, etc.** (flatten if possible)
- **Empty Aerosol Cans**

NOT RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING

All the Following Should Not Be Placed Out for Curbside Pickup:

- **Any plastic item without a stamped recycling number #1 thru #7**
- **Styrofoam™** (cups, containers, packing peanuts, etc.)
- **Plastic Bags or plastic wrap**
- **Batteries**
- **CDs, DVDs, or VHS tapes**
- **Window glass, broken dishes, ceramics, light bulbs**
- **Clothing**
- **Food Waste**
