The September 16, 2013 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was called to order at 7:30PM.

**Resident Concern – Safety of Joggers on LMT Roadway** - Nathan Smith, a resident and member of Boy Scout Troop 10, and his father, were in attendance. Nathan is working on the Citizenship in the Community merit badge. To fulfill one of the requirements, he interviewed the CTC regarding his concern that there are no signs in LMT about sharing the road with runners. He reported that he and his father were almost hit by a speeding car while jogging along Mt. Eyre Road. Nathan presented a petition signed by 25 friends requesting that “Share the Road” signs be posted in Lower Makefield. Mr. Hyman will find out if Mt. Eyre Road is a State road and will research signs in Pennsylvania for any that might be appropriate and PennDOT-approved.

**Discussion of Safe Driving Event** – Mrs. Herman reported on a Safe Driving Event meeting scheduled for the following day at Pennsbury to finalize plans for the October 2, 2013 End Distracted Driving Event at Pennsbury High School.

**Traffic Calming Guidelines, Next Steps** – Mrs. Torbert has sent the guidelines to the Township Traffic Engineer, Amy Kaminski, but has not heard back to date. Mr. Benedetto suggested she forward them to Chief Coluzzi.

**Approval of May 2013 and June 2013 Meeting Minutes** – The May and June minutes were approved unanimously, as written.

**Other Business – Accident Reports** – Mrs. Torbert reported that Chief Coluzzi sent accident reports from March through June 2013. She requested that CTC members review all 2013 accident reports prior to the next CTC meeting.

**Online Deer Map** - Mr. Benedetto will ask the Township to put the deer map online.

**Aria** – Aria is presenting a revised plan at the September 18 Board of Supervisors Meeting for their property at the corner of Stony Hill Road and the Newtown Bypass.

With no further business to discuss, the September 16, 2013 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was adjourned at 8:30PM. The next meeting of the CTC will be held on **October 21, 2013**, at 7:30PM, at the LMT municipal building.
