Updates on Resident Traffic Concerns –

- Flashing Light in front of St. John's School – There is nothing new to report.
- East School lane Speeding/Cut-Through – Mr. Weaner visited this area three times, on different days, at different times, and found no evidence of high volume or excessive speeds. He will make additional visits to confirm his findings. He noted that the speed machine had been installed on East School Lane when he was there.
- Longmeadow Lane Speeding – Mrs. Torbert requested speed limit signs but hasn't heard anything.
- Forest Drive Stop Signs – Mr. Benedetto is following up.
- Big Oak/Oxford Valley Road Intersection – There is nothing new to report.
- Bluestone – There is a 25 mph speed limit sign on Bluestone. Mrs. Torbert asked Mr. Davino to have the information on this complaint in writing for discussion at the May meeting.

Deer Accident Map – Mrs. Torbert distributed the introduction to the map, which included Mr. Hyman's changes. She asked Mrs. Bray to talk to the Township staff about renaming the link to the map to be more descriptive..

Traffic Calming Guidelines – There was discussion of Mr. Hyman's changes to the guidelines. Mrs. Torbert asked Mr. Hyman to e-mail her the draft and she will make the changes that were discussed and send them out to the CTC.

Approval of March 28, 2013 CTC Meeting Minutes – The minutes will be approved at the May meeting.

Other Business – Mr. Hyman said he understands that, in Pennsylvania, you can turn right on red even when there is a red "ball" provided there is no other signing to prohibit turning.

Mrs. Torbert suggested that the CTC have a tent and table at Harvest Day in September. This will be decided at the May meeting.

Mr. Weaner was reelected to the CTC for another four-year term. Mr. Hogan is currently up for reelection. Mr. Hyman has applied for membership in the CTC; there is one other candidate.

With no further business to discuss, the April 15, 2013 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was adjourned at 9:00PM. The next meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission will be held on Monday, May 20, 2013, at 7:30PM, in the LMT municipal building, downstairs.
