The Tournament, once again, would like to remind the Board that all of the estimates quoted and expenses involved in these projects will be paid for by the Pennsbury Tournament, LLC.

We are following up, as requested, with a time line:

A). The Bull Pen Project: We would love to have this ready for the beginning of the PAA spring season, April 1, 2019, we have a quote that was provided by County Line Fence for the work to be done on the outside of the fields at Fred Allan, approved I believe at the Park and Rec Board Meeting already.

This also includes the installation of home plates and pitching rubbers, purchased already with invoices provided and installed by the volunteers at PAA.

The Project also includes fence repairs, entry gate repairs and a protective fence by the new installed batting cage.

B). Fence Adjustment Project, tentatively scheduled for Spring 2020, see invoice provided for additional information.

C). Outfield Fence Adjustment Project, tentatively scheduled for Fall 2020, see invoice provided for additional information.
