

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Special Public Meeting Summary
April 7, 2010

At its regular public meeting of Wednesday, April 7, 2010, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Tabled pending corrections of the minutes of the March 17, 2010, public meeting;
2. Approved granting free pool memberships for active volunteer Yardley-Makefield fire fighters;
3. Historical Commission made presentation on Patterson Farm Janney-Brown and Satterthwaite Houses;
4. Had final report on deer management program;
5. Approved Development Agreement for an addition to the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection;
6. Granted extensions of time as follows:
 - a. Zubaida Foundation, Big Oak Road, to July 22, 2010
 - b. The Gatherings at Yardley, Dobry Road, to July 15, 2010
7. Moved to leave the following appeals to the Zoning Hearing Board:
 - a. William and Susan Jenny, 21 Olivia Drive, request variance to construct a swimming pool resulting in greater than permitted impervious surface
 - b. Bruce Mittleman, 301 Frazer Drive, requests variance to construct a fence within a buffer easement
8. Moved to have the Township Solicitor participate in the appeal of Steven Kortick, 412 Honeysuckle Court, to construct a garage resulting in greater than permitted impervious surface.
9. Approved Resolution No. 2206 supporting an application to the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission's Compact Authorized Investment Program for a Pedestrian/Bicycle Trail along Black Rock Road;

10. Approved Resolution 2207 – Sewer Planning Modules for Capstone Terrace;
11. Awarded 2010-2011 Stone and Asphalt Bids through the Bucks County Consortium as recommended by the Public Works Director;
12. Awarded 2010-2012 Sign Materials and Post Bids through Bucks County Consortium as recommended by the Public Works Director;
13. Approved hiring two new police officers – Robert Kennedy and Brian Pontarelli;
14. Moved to cancel public meetings scheduled for July 7 and August 4, 2010.
