

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Public Meeting Summary
June 2, 2010

At its regular public meeting of Wednesday, June 2, 2010, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Approved minutes from the May 19, 2010, public meeting as written;
2. Stanley Booz, CPA, presented the 20009 Township Audit;
3. Moved to support restoration of the R-8 Newtown Rail Line;
4. Approved with conditions the Sandra Middlemiss final plan for a three-lot subdivision at Mahlon and Stackhouse Drive;
5. Granted extension of time to September 30, 2010, for the Jennings Tract preliminary land development plan;
6. Moved to have the Township Solicitor participate in the Zoning Hearing Board appeal of Thomas Anzabi, 1528 Clark Drive;
7. Rejected all bids received for the Garden of Reflection Lighting Replacement Project;
8. Moved to waive the thirty-day review period and reduce the public comment period to fourteen days in regard to the Township LED Lighting Replacement Project, will consider awarding the bid at the June 16 meeting.
