If you want one of the 6 veterans branch symbols – army, navy, air force, marine corp., coast guard or merchant marines, note that on your order and your paver can have up to 3 lines with 12 characters each, including punctuation and spaces.

**8 by 8" Brick for \$250** – can have up to 5 lines, 20 characters per line including punctuation and spaces.

Must have lived in LMT or Yardley at some point in his/her lifetime.

Submit: First name, Middle initial, Last name, Rank, Branch, War/Conflict or theater

As in - Joe L. Smith, Pvt., USA, WWII

New plaque will be created when we have 75 names. Proof of residency and veteran status required, as in DD214 discharge form, VFW or American Legion membership, or other proof.
