

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Public Meeting Summary
APRIL 6, 2016

At its regular public meeting of Wednesday, April 6, 2016, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Proclamation was given to the Pennsbury High School Girls Cross Country Team
2. Directed Township Manager to send a letter to the offender who took down trees near the Scammel's Development outlining the violation of the Ordinance.
3. Approved moving the dog park over 50' on the sketch plan; reducing the size of the small dog section to .8 acres and proceed with a friendly condemnation with Makefield Glen
4. Approved Minutes of March 16, 2016 Public Meeting as written
5. Approved, with conditions, Preliminary/Final Plans of Pennsbury School District application for land development for middle school campus improvements.
6. Presentation of tree planting program given by Alan Dresser. Moved to execute the Arboretum Plan planting 25 trees from the Boucher & James proposal and do the planting the weekend of April 29th and 30th. Authorized Judy Goldstein of Boucher & James to craft a 25 year tree replacement plan.
7. Moved to accept the highest bid from Charlann Farms and awarding five year farming lease.
8. Moved to authorize the Township officials to take appropriate next step to advance the Conservation Easement with Bucks County to preserve Patterson Farm
9. Approved purchase of Jennings Tract
