The June 18, 2012 meeting of the LMT Citizens Traffic Commission was called to order at 7:30PM.

**Approve Minutes** – The May 21, 2012 CTC minutes were approved unanimously, as written.

**CTC Accomplishments/Activities Update** – Mrs. Herman distributed copies of the updated and revised CTC Accomplishments list. After discussion, it was decided that the following steps should be taken:

- Mr. Davino and Mr. Weaner will update the deer accident reports portion, before the August CTC meeting.
- A table of contents will be added.
- Mrs. Herman will add dates to each action item.
- Mrs. Tyler will discuss the procedure for installing additional deer crossing signs with Chief Coluzzi.
- Ms. Bray will update the safety information relative to avoiding deer vehicle collisions that is on the LMT website.
- Mrs. Torbert will draft a cover letter.
- Mrs. Herman will send the CTC Accomplishments to members of the CTC, who will send their suggested changes to her before June 26th. Mrs. Herman will incorporate the changes and return the package to Mrs. Torbert by July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Residents' Traffic Concerns** –

Stoopville Road/Rt. 413 Intersection Upgrade - There is no new information available on this project.

Oxford Valley and Big Oak Intersection - Mrs. Torbert had contacted Chief Coluzzi about potential problems stemming from cars turning right on red onto Oxford Valley Road at the same time that other cars are turning left from Big Oak. Chief Coluzzi spoke to someone at PennDOT, who indicated that they don't want to limit right hand turns. With regard to the lane confusion in front of the Shell Station, the Township was told that they would have to install any additional signage.

**Updates** –

Aria Hospital – A decision from the Zoning Hearing Board is expected at their July 17th meeting.

Highland Area Speed Study – Mrs. Torbert provided a written update from the LMT police department on this resident complaint, which left some questions unanswered. Mrs. Tyler offered to talk to Chief Coluzzi and get back to Mrs. Torbert, who will then contact the resident.

**Supervisor Liaison Update** – Mrs. Tyler reported that she had talked to Mr. Fedorchak about putting resident traffic concerns on the Township website, and he was in favor.

Mrs. Tyler will follow up with the Township traffic engineer re scheduling a meeting with the CTC.

Mrs. Tyler will announce that there are one or two openings on the CTC at the next Board of Supervisors meeting.

**New Business** – Mrs. Herman and Mr. Weaner are up for reappointment to the Citizens Traffic Commission.

Mrs. Torbert cancelled the July meeting; the next meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission will be held on Monday, August 20<sup>th</sup>, at 7:30PM at the LMT municipal building. With no further business to discuss, the June 18, 2012 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was adjourned at 8:40PM.
