

Recycling and Disposal Alternatives for Various Household Items

Residential curbside recycling programs will accept some items for recycling, but not all. This guide addresses items that come up in everyday life but cannot be put in the curbside recycling bin. What follows is an alphabetical list of products and material and where they can be taken for recycling and/or reuse. Most options are free of charge and close to LMT. Guidance on the Bucks County hazardous waste collection events and curbside recycling is also given.

Appendix B - LMT Residential Recycling Rules and Tips

Item	Rule	Tip
Plastic Bottles & Containers	Plastic water, juice, etc. bottles; plastic jars, jugs, and tubs (only #1 thru #5)	Empty bottles and other plastic containers. Caps are recyclable but put it back on the container.
Food & Beverage Cans	Tin, aluminum, and steel cans	Remove plastic lids from any food or beverage cans before recycling.
Paper Cardboard &	Newspaper, and magazines, office paper, junk mail	Remove staples and paper clips. Soiled and wet paper should be placed in the trash
Paperboard	Cereal boxes and all other paperboard, milk and juice cartons, cardboard	Break down and flatten cardboard and paperboard boxes, there will be more room in your recycling bin. Remove shipping labels.
Glass Bottles & Containers	Glass food and beverage containers (clear, green, and brown)	Rinse and dry containers. Caps are recyclable but put it back on the container.
