DCNR GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT: Lower Makefield Township has been awarded \$250,000 for "further development of Memorial Park. Work will include construction of pedestrian walkways, tennis courts, bocce ball courts, horseshoe pits, gazebo, and pavilion; installation of fitness station equipment with required safety surfacing and fencing; ADA access, landscaping, project sign and other related site improvements."

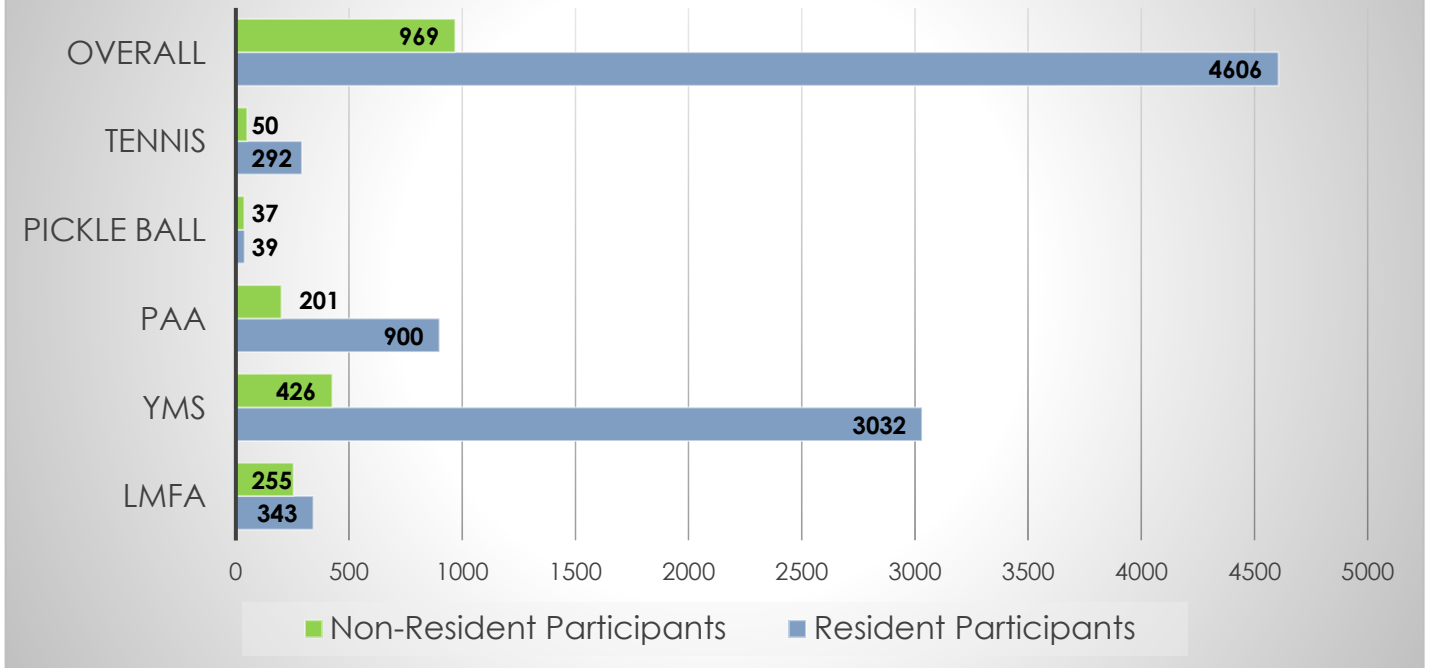
Bike Path: Bike path cleanup is underway to remove debris from the fall season.
