FACILITIES/PROGRAM UPDATE

Macclesfield Park: Friday November 2, 2018 I performed a walkthrough with Steve Beede and LMT Park Crew leader to discuss the state of the fields. The heavy rains and overuse had an impact on field quality this season. LMT P&R will be working to seed and treat the grass for the 2019 season in the upcoming weeks. There was also some discussion about a drainage issue due to a collapsing drainage pipe. We will be working to remedy that before the ground freezes.

Memorial Park: We had an arborist look at the trees in the arboretum and give us advice about their maintenance and up keep. Some of the trees will need to be replaced and are still under warranty

Garden of Reflection: We had an arborist come look at some of our trees in the GoR to determine their health. It was determined that several trees can be revived by a tree health specialist, but some will be removed. We are working on a plan to remove and replace the trees.

Community Center: Aiden McNamara has been working to install his Eagle Scout Project in the space behind the Community Center. We hope to see complete cornhole set up in the upcoming weeks.

Pool: We are in the planning process of working on the pool wall for FY2019.

Special Events Committee: The special Events Committee met in October and will not be meeting until the new year.

In our October meeting we discussed sponsorship and how we may consider a more comprehensive plan for 2020. This year we will start our sponsorship campaign in December for Community Pride Day.
