## LMT PARKS AND RECREATION REPORT

#### UPDATES

**Dog Park:** We are experiencing significant problems with our dog park gate system. The problem happened in the original integration of the dog park software and how it reads the signal from the lock system. We are working to make it easier and more fluid.

The solution will be twofold:

- 1. We will be changing out the gate swipe system to be an optical scanner. We will continue to use the same key fobs.
- The software company is working to rewrite the way the software communicates with the lock system. This will make it a much easier process and will eliminate the need to rely on internet connectivity.

We plan to have this remedy in the upcoming weeks. Once we have a firm fix in place we will extend all members memberships to cover the lost time at the dog park. At this time many people are still able to access the gate but it has been temperamental.

**Trees/Shade:** There will be 41 trees planted at the Dog Park this fall. We are currently seeking quotes. We will also be mending the fence between the dog park and Makefield Glen.

### FACILITIES/PROGRAM UPDATE

**Veterans Park:** The installation of the walk way will begin. We will be using solid Gold Construction for the project. Now that the project has started there should be a very quick turnaround.

**Stoddart/Ciaola/Fred Allan:** PAA continues to make updates to the Baseball and Softball Complexes.

**Memorial Park:** Although there was a threat of rain we lucked out and were able to hold two ceremonies at the GOR this year. Everything went smoothly even though we had to make last minute changes due to the weather.

We had a plant Health specialist look at the trees and plants at the GOR to determine what we can do to repair some of the dead trees and dry spots in some of the ground cover. We will get a report in the upcoming weeks.

We are also looking to have the trees in the arboretum that did not survive the winter replaced and the remainder of the trees we purchased planted.

**Community Center:** Our sound system has been installed and is functioning in the Community Center. Classes continue to thrive in the center. We are officially a 7 day a week operation.

**Pool:** I met with RVE to review the pool wall and the bathrooms. In preparation to update them in 2019. The goal would be to start the project as soon as possible in order to avoid missing any swim season. I will provide an update in October.

**Special Events Committee:** The special Events Committee met September 25<sup>th</sup> to review Community Pride Day and we continued to discuss the Veterans Day Events. It was determined through 2017 feedback that the ceremony was too long. This year we worked to abbreviate the ceremony and build up the Parade with the understanding of what the day is all about. We are working to add more military presence and add more music. We will be doing this by reaching out to local military installations, and other local veteran groups. We have also been working with the Veterans Committee to determine a Parade Marshall, we should be able to announce our selection at the next meeting.
