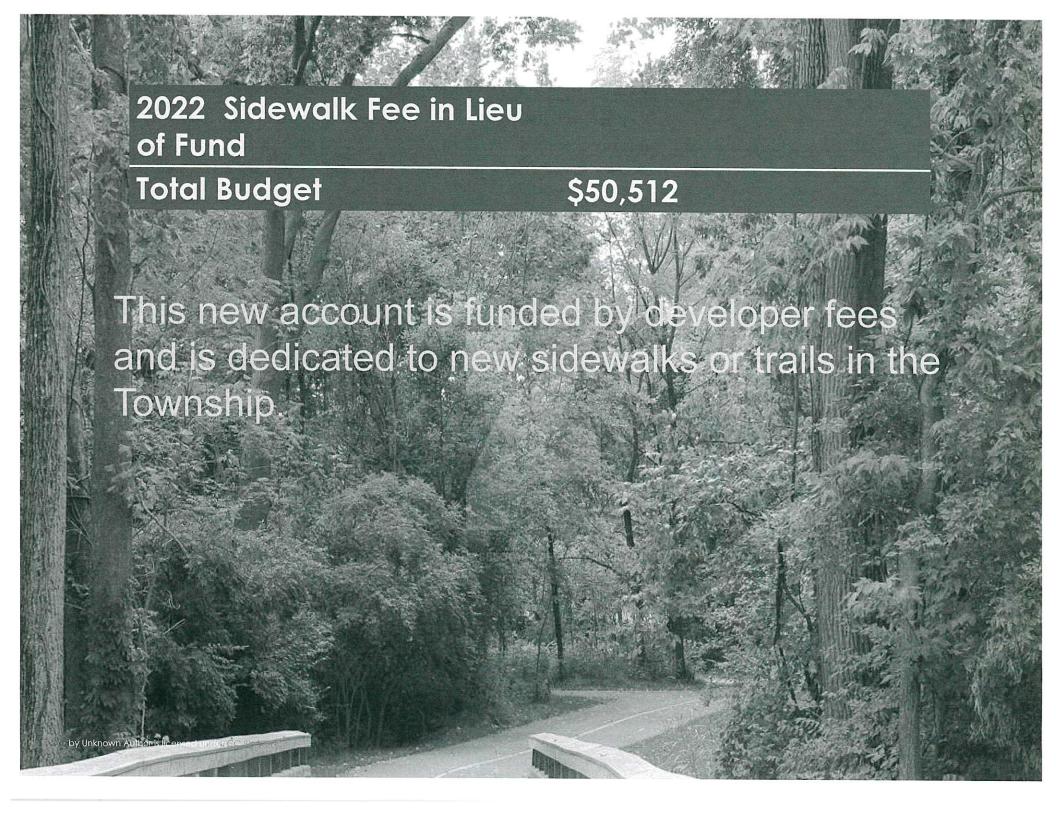
The department currently is responsible for 550 acres of parkland, 25 miles of bike path, and the pool.

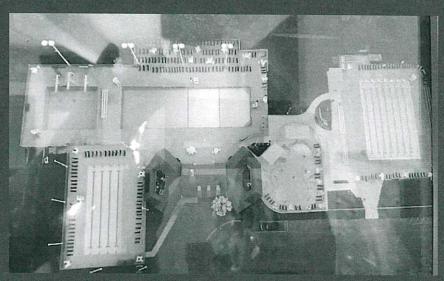

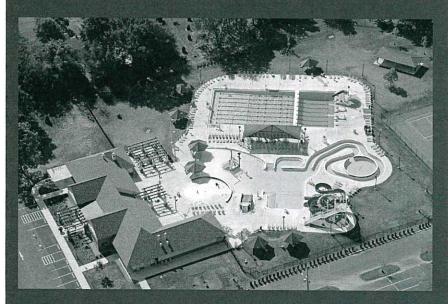
