Near Miss Incident MV 1/24/22

Incident:

I fielded a telephone call from a motorist who wanted to report an incident involving a township truck.

The motorist stated that earlier this morning (1/24/2022), he was entering the traffic circle at Schuyler and Edgewood Road. He stated that he entered the circle and was navigating same when he observed a township truck, traveling east on Edgewood Road, enter the traffic circle without yielding. This action reportedly caused the motorist to take evasive action, driving up into the center of the circle. The motorist said that he was then behind the truck and observed it enter the township complex just before the traffic circle at Mill Road. The motorist said that the truck was clearly a municipal vehicle, pick-up style with utility boxes. He claimed that the truck appeared to be speeding on Edgewood Road and failed to yield when entering the traffic circle at Schuyler. He could not provide any additional information about the truck.

In speaking with the motorist, he seemed satisfied that the matter would be brought to the attention of the appropriate department and did not request any additional follow-up contact/call back regarding his report.
