

INFORMATION FROM OCTOBER 20TH **MEET & GREET**

Our guests at our October Meet & Greet were Pete Lange a detective with the Lower Makefield Police and representatives from other agencies (Special Agent Sunny Notani (United States Secret Service), Mike Bannon (Bucks County Weights and Measures), and Deputy District Attorney, AJ Garabedian (Bucks County District Attorney's Office, Chief of Elder Abuse/ Economic Crimes). Detective Lange and the other representatives were extremely informative and concerned.


