

CHARLES ANDERSON FOUND DROWNED

YARDLEY, Dec. 23.—The body of Charles Anderson, seventy-five years old, was found in Lake Aftco yesterday afternoon, by children returning from Sunday School. It is thought that Anderson fell into the lake Saturday night.

Mr. Anderson was a musician of ability. In his younger days his services were sought for social functions where music was desired, and it was no uncommon sight for years to see Mr. Anderson walking about the streets fiddling.

Mr. Anderson is survived by a brother, Watson Anderson, of this place, and has a nephew, B. Frank Anderson, living in Trenton.

Coroner White decided an inquest unnecessary. The body was removed to the residence of Constable Wist and the funeral arrangements are in charge of Morris.

The funeral will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, from the home of his brother, Watson Anderson.
