FULL-TIME PUBLIC WORKS LABORERS & EQUIPMENT OPERATORS

The Lower Makefield Township Department of Public Works has immediate openings for full-time Public Works laborers and equipment operators. Interested applicants must have the ability and willingness to work overtime and respond to after-hour emergencies. This would include forecasted winter and severe weather events along with call-ins for emergency responses.

The positions require the ability to work outside even in extreme temperatures, salting and plowing roads, and a variety of skill sets. Skills include: construction background, road repair and maintenance experience, concrete work, equipment/engine maintenance and repair, heavy equipment operation, truck driving, and the ability to work and function as a productive and positive member of the Department for the residents of Lower Makefield Township. Laborers are required to have a valid driver's license. Operators are required to have a Class B CDL with the ability to obtain a Class A within 1-year of hiring.

The starting rate for laborers is \$31.00/hour for a base annual rate of \$64,480.00 and Operator I is \$35.00/hour for a base annual rate of 72,800.00. These positions have excellent benefits and ample opportunity for pay advancements based upon skills obtained and years of service, in accordance with the current Collective Bargaining Agreement.
