3. New Business:

- a. Shady Brook Feedback request from LMT. Cathy stated that this was requested by since the scope of the work does not include any historic buildings we made no feedback.

4. Existing Business:

Next month we have a speak from a program in Philadelphia who does this work to explain their process.

- e. America 250 Activities- Monica and Helen to work out the time capusule proffect. when new one arrives.Park and Rec agreed to support an effort with the kids in summer camps submitting items for the time capsule. Tom will pursue other locations for the time capsule to be buried.

- f. Archiving project proceeding slowly. Volunteer Liz continues to focus on this.

- g. Slate Hill Cathy Monica reported about some teens returning to do some clean up as they have done in prior years. QR code pages are progressing and should be ready to go to Tom soon. Archiving Project.

- h. Patterson Farm Register Nomination Joe got amazing feedback and is trying to submit all changes by June so that this application can be heard in 2026. The main issues were formatting and length.
