

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Public Meeting Summary
September 15, 2010

At its regular public meeting of Wednesday, September 15, 2010, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions:

1. Approved minutes from the September 1, 2010, public meeting as written;
2. Approved September 7, 2010 warrant list and August payroll;
3. Approved Ordinance No. 385 authorizing a bond issue in the amount of \$5.6 million to refinance the 2003 General Obligation Bond;
4. Authorized advertising an Ordinance to re-enact local services tax for the year 2011;
5. Approved homeowner's request for extinguishment of an easement at 16 Houston Road with the homeowner to bear all costs involved;
6. Discussed deliveries of unsolicited newspapers, directed Solicitor to write letter to publishers;
7. Approved preliminary/final plan for Zubaida Foundation with conditions;
8. Approved extensions of time for Jennings Tract to December 30, 2010, and for Fieldstone at Lower Makefield 496 to December 31, 2010;
9. Moved to petition the Supreme Court for an Appeal in the Dalgewicz matter;
10. Moved to have Township participate in the Woodway Construction/Schaunn McKamey Zoning matter and leave the Shrank matter to the Zoning Hearing Board;

11. Awarded bid for painting of community pools to J.P.Smith Contractors in the amount of \$44,970;
12. Rescheduled December 1 Board of Supervisors meeting to November 30 due to Hanukkah;
13. Approved hiring Jason Landis as a police officer.
