The regularly scheduled meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was opened by Vice Chair, Ginni Torbert, at 7:35PM.

Meeting Minutes – The CTC minutes from September 21, 2009 meeting were approved unanimously, with one change.

October 24 Safe Driving Event – The second annual Safe Driving Event was the primary focus of the meeting. The following action item assignments were agreed upon:

#### Lindenhurst Traffic Calming

Sue mentioned that there are more reflectors along Lindenhurst Road, and wondered if Heather Sherk was responsible for having those installed. Ginni will check with Heather. Also, there are more reflectors on Rt. 332 near the Yardley Methodist Church. They are for nighttime delineation and about an inch high.

Accident Data Collection – The Township had forwarded to the CTC every accident reported for the last two years but had not responded to a request for more detailed information. Dick will take the two years of information and analyze. Jeanne offered to talk to the EAC Chair in Newtown Township to get more information on their program to monitor deer vehicle accidents. Terry Fedorchak will also be forwarding additional information from the State Game Commission on deer carcass removal. This issue will be discussed at the November CTC meeting.

Edgewood Crossing – Will be discussed in November.

Flowers Fields – Ginni reported that their preliminary plan has been submitted to the Township. The CTC has not yet received a copy.

Future Meetings – Because of national holidays, the first two CTC meetings in 2010 will be Thursdays, January 21 and February 18, respectively.

The next meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission will be November 16, 2009, at the LMT Municipal Building at 7:30PM.
