Mrs. Torbert called the June meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission to order at 7:30PM.

Snipes Wrap Up and Next Steps – Mrs. Torbert and Mrs. Calabria had attended the special meeting on the Snipes Fields held by the BOS. Their impression was that the BOS is ready to proceed and eager to get the project done. The CTC is concerned about the intersection of Creamery and Quarry Roads. It is expected that there will be no changes to the intersection at this time because of the expense but it was agreed that, eventually, some changes will have to be made. Mrs. Torbert suggested that a traffic study should be done before any work outside of the current plan is considered.

Latest Dunkin Donuts/Day Care Sketch Plan - There was discussion of the Dunkin Donuts' plan and concerns expressed about potential serious traffic backups, particularly in the morning. Mr. Benedetto's impression of the BOS reaction to the plan is that this location is an improvement over the original location. Mr. Benedetto will find out what next steps are and believes the plan will go to the Planning Commission in July.

Other Business –

Mrs. Herman reported that, in her opinion, the lights on the Newtown Bypass are better synchronized since work was done.

Mr. Benedetto will follow up on the Sandy Run Road update report.

Residents in the Highland Road neighborhood have reported that things are better since the signs were installed. Mrs. Torbert suggested that, in the Fall, the CTC should revisit the subject of police enforcement of the trucks working on Scudder Falls Bridge.

Mrs. Torbert had received Plans for the Dogwood Drive project. Since there are only 5 houses, the CTC members agreed there should be no traffic issues.

With no further business to discuss, the June 19 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was adjourned at 9:00. The next meeting of the CTC will be held on August 21, 2017, in the LMT Municipal Building.
