Comprehensive Plan Update Mrs. Torbert reviewed the proposed changes to the “Transportation Planning” section of the Comprehensive Plan Update. A few minor changes were suggested and incorporated. Mrs. Torbert will forward the suggested revisions to the Planning Commission for their review.

Makefield Road Safety Analysis It was noted that the Makefield Road Safety Analysis was on the agenda for the Wednesday, March 21, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting and any Commission members available were asked to attend.

Resident Traffic Complaints Mrs. Torbert reviewed recent traffic complaints submitted to the Township and/or the CTC. One resident requested a light-controlled crosswalk at Oxford Valley Road and Tall Pines Lane for residents of Regency at Yardley. Mrs. Torbert spoke to the resident by phone and Mr. Cohn visited with him and provided a copy of the Traffic Calming Guidelines and invited him to a future meeting.

Another resident had a complaint about the intersection of Big Oak and Oxford Valley Road, having almost had an accident while turning right toward the mall from Big Oak. Mrs. Torbert sent him an email explaining the history of issues with that intersection and that she would put the issue on the April meeting agenda.

A resident living near Quarry Hill School complained of speeding in front of the school and in front of Afton Elementary, as well as the lack of a speed limit sign on Quarry for traffic making a left from Creamery Road. Mrs. Torbert will contact LMT police about replacing the 25 mph speed limit sign as well as requesting enhanced enforcement in the area.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 9:00 pm. The next meeting of the CTC will be Monday, April 16th at 7:30 pm at the Township Building.
