

SCUDDERS FALLS BRIDGE PROJECT TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGE RAMPS AT TAYLORSVILLE & I-295

Starting Tuesday August 7th, the 2 new sets of signals at Taylorsville and I-295 were put on flash. On Tuesday August 14th at 1am these traffic signals will be set for normal operation (barring weather delays).

As the new ramps are not completed yet, a combination of existing ramps and some temporary ramps will handle the traffic for West bound I-295 (SB I-95) exiting at Taylorsville Rd.

Whereas as previously, traffic intending to go north on Taylorsville Rd towards New Hope, had their own separate exit, that traffic will now exit to the new signal the same as traffic intending to go south on Taylorsville Rd towards Yardley. At that signal, traffic can either turn right or left to travel in their desired direction.

For traffic traveling East bound on I-295 (NB I-95), exiting for New Hope or Yardley, north bound Taylorsville Rd traffic will see no difference except for a traffic signal instead of the Stop Sign. This ramp will be redesigned as the project moves forward.
