Meeting Minutes

Present: Virginia Torbert, Chair; Suzanne Blundi, BOS Liaison; Bill Hogan; Catherine Chia-Calabria; Scott Weaner

Mrs. Torbert called the meeting to order at 7:30pm.

KINGS ROAD/EDGEWOOD ROAD - A resident of Baron Drive requested that the street light on Edgewood Road across the entrance to Kings Road be fixed as it makes it difficult to locate Kings Road at night. The resident also requested that the timing of the traffic signal at the intersection of Black Rock/Edgewood and Yardley-Morrisville Road be checked as he believes the green phase for Black Rock/Edgewood traffic is too short and causes backups. The resident also inquired if the signal timing can be different during rush hour to allow for a longer green light when there are more vehicles using Black Rock/Edgewood Road. Mrs. Torbert will relay this request to the Township.

DERBYSHIRE AND ROELOFS - The improvements to this intersection and the intersection of Roelofs and Ramsey were discussed. These will include stop bars and the pavement wording STOP at these intersections. Similar improvements are also planned for the intersection of Kings and Ramsey.

WILLIAM PENN MIDDLE SCHOOL ZONE - CTC members questioned why there is no school zone in front of William Penn Middle School. Members do believe some children walk and bike along Derbyshire to reach William Penn and a school zone would make it safer for them. Mrs. Torbert will contact Captain Roche to inquire about how to find out why there is no school zone and what the procedure is for requesting a school zone.

ERIN DEVELOPMENT/DOBRY ROAD - Mrs. Torbert noted that the Preliminary Plan for this age-restricted 76-unit housing development has likely gone back to the developer for changes as an extension has been requested till July. She will contact Jim Majewski for more details.

FEBRUARY MINUTES The February CTC minutes were approved as written.

OTHER BUSINESS

- Mrs. Torbert believes the **Traffic Problem Reporting Form**, part of the **Traffic Calming Guidelines**, needs some revisions to provide additional details useful to the CTC in reviewing the request. CTC members suggested a few revisions. Mrs. Torbert will prepare a draft of the revised form and circulate to members for review.

With no further business to discuss, the March 18, 2019 meeting of the Citizens Traffic Commission was adjourned at 9:15pm. The next meeting of the CTC will be held on Monday, April 15, 2019 at 7:30pm in the LMT Municipal Building.
